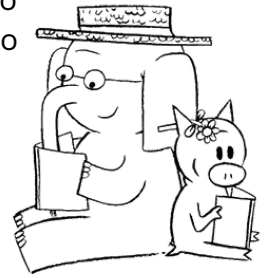




## LITERACY MONTH HOMEWORK

This year we will be doing things a little different. We are going to have so much fun! Your literacy work will be displayed around the school for all to enjoy. Here's how to show have it showcased.

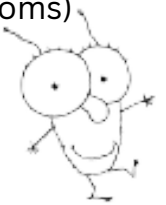


1. Create a news paper article inspired by your favorite book (up to 15 pts)
2. Write a one-paragraph response to a writing prompt (up to 10 pts)
3. Create a new word for the for the word wall (5 pts)
4. Create a LEGO creation with a theme from your favorite book (10 pts)

You may do as many writing assignments as you'd like. LEGO creations limited to ONE. Find the article and prompt sheets in your classroom, parent square, or front office. Keep reading for details on each project...

### Newspaper Article or Advertisement (Grades 2-5)

- Fill out a brainstorming sheet provided (in class) for the advertisement or news article
- Turn in typed, proofread and edited article, including a picture that is news worthy of presentation (If typing at home is difficult for you, let your teacher know and they can help you)
- Include on front of page: 1) Your name 2) Teachers name 3)Team name 4) Title of Article/Advertisement ( there will be a news template students can use in their classrooms)



### Writing Prompt (Grades 2-5)

- Decide which prompt you would like to respond to
- Write a rough draft and edit it
- Turn in a typed proofread and edited paragraph (If typing at home is difficult for you, let your teacher know and they can help you)
- Include on front of page: 1) Your name 2) Teachers name 3)Team name 4) Title of Writing Prompt



### Word wall Vocabulary Card (Any Grade)

- Use ½ sheet of paper
- Pick a word specific to your favorite book series
- Write/type the word in marker/boldface and make it BIG to be able to read it from afar
- Add a picture and definition
- Include on front of page: 1) Your name 2) Teachers name 3)Team name

### LEGO Creations (Any Grade)

Literacy can lead readers to creative thought. You may build a LEGO creations inspired by the magic of your favorite book. Ideas are in this packet, but don't feel limited to the list.

- Build your creation
- Take and print a picture (you may be in the picture if you like)
- Include on front of page: 1) Your name 2) Teachers name 3)Team name 4) Label of your creation  
ex. Dr. Seuss Hat
